

Instructions for At Home Students for testing (changes in red):

Who must report to school:

- These are State mandated tests and all students enrolled in these classes are required to take the tests.
- These tests count 15% of the student's total average for the class and can cause students to fail the class and have to go to summer school or retake that same class next year if they do not take the test.
- Both At Home and In Person students should be present at Soddy Daisy High School in person for these tests:
 - **Tuesday, May 4 -- English 9, Geometry & DE Math classes**
 - **Wednesday, May 5 – English 9, Geometry 10, Algebra 2 & AP Lit**
 - **Thursday, May 6 – English 9, Algebra 2, AP US History**
 - **Friday, May 7 – SDC Statistics & Pre-Cal, English 10, Geometry 9 & SDC Speech**
 - **Tuesday, May 11 – Algebra 1, English 10, Geometry 9, AP Spanish & SDC Speech**
 - **Wednesday, May 12 – Algebra 1, English 10 and AP Language**
 - **Biology – May 13**

Time and Location for Arrival:

- At Home students who need to report in the morning for testing due to transportation issues will follow our regular class testing schedule and may be picked up at 9:30 or remain for the day and follow their schedule.
- At Home students who can arrive later, should report for testing at 11:00 a.m. and enter through the attendance door #7 on the football field side of the building, which is also the designated pick-up site.
- All At Home students arriving at 11:00 will report directly to the media center (3rd door on the right in the Commons) where they will have small group, socially-distanced testing sessions each day in accordance with the testing schedule posted on the website.
- At Home students will be distanced from all other students for the entire time they are in the building and all safety protocols will be followed.

What to Bring:

- State Dual Credit test on Friday will be on the Chromebook, so bring your fully charged Chromebook. All other tests will be paper/pencil, so no electronics should be brought into the building, including cell phones, smart watches, tablets and Chromebooks, unless the student is remaining at school for classes the rest of the day.
- Bring two #2 pencils with erasers; **and for the math tests, bring a TI84 calculator for Algebra or TI30 calculators for Geometry.**

Time and Location for Pickup:

- At Home students who arrive in the morning at 7:00 may be picked up at 9:30 at the attendance door #7 on the football field side or remain and follow their regular school schedule for the entire day. If a student remains at school for classes, we will not be able to socially distance but masks are worn.
- At Home students who arrive at 11:00 may be picked up at 1:20 at the attendance door #7 on the football field side.
- All In Person students will remain at school all day and follow their regular schedule. They will attend all classes after testing for regular instruction and review. We ask that parents NOT check students out after testing is over. They will be counted absent and will miss valuable information in their classes.
