

Hello, Soddy Daisy Community. We at Soddy Daisy High School would like to better inform you about expectations for students for the next two weeks and possibly longer.

School work: At this moment, students will work from home using their chrome books. Teachers communicated with students Friday about how they will assign information to them. If your child was absent, they should email the teacher and check their class landing pages, such as Google Classroom or Canvas. If your child does not have internet access, Spectrum is offering free internet service for the next couple of weeks. Simply call 1-844-488-8395. They will guide you in setting up the free service. Students will be expected to be working online in their classes while we are not physically in school. If you prefer your students have paper packets, they will be available at school only for tested subjects on Tuesday. You may pick these up during school hours. Administration will be in the main office.

Food: Hamilton County Schools will serve food to our students during this time of online learning. Our students at Soddy Daisy High School can receive services at North Hamilton Elementary, Allen Elementary, Soddy Elementary, Daisy Elementary, Middle Valley Elementary, Hixson Elementary, and McConnell Elementary Schools. The schools will hand out breakfast from 7-9 am and lunch from 11-1: 00 pm. beginning tomorrow, Tuesday, March 17. When you arrive, there will be number posted on the door for you to call and someone will bring the food to you. The student must be present to receive food services. You will not be allowed to go into the school.

Dual Enrollment: If your student is participating in a Dual Enrollment class, UT-Martin is aware of the difficulties in our situation as well. They, too, have closed campus. Students should continue to work closely with their Soddy Daisy High School teacher to ensure success. As a reminder, students can call the Spectrum number at the beginning of this message if they need free internet service. A student's grade will not be negatively affected by the recent health events.

Meetings: If you are a senior, the TN Promise meeting originally scheduled for Tuesday will be held virtually. Seniors, see your email from the College Counseling Department. All other previously scheduled meetings are cancelled at this time, and you will be notified regarding future meetings.
