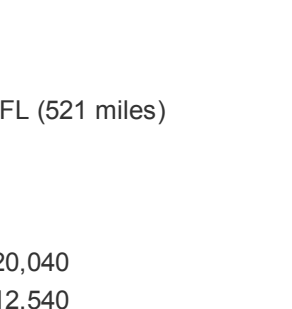
FUN FACT

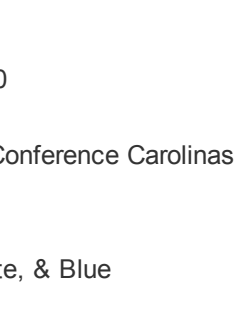
FUN FACT

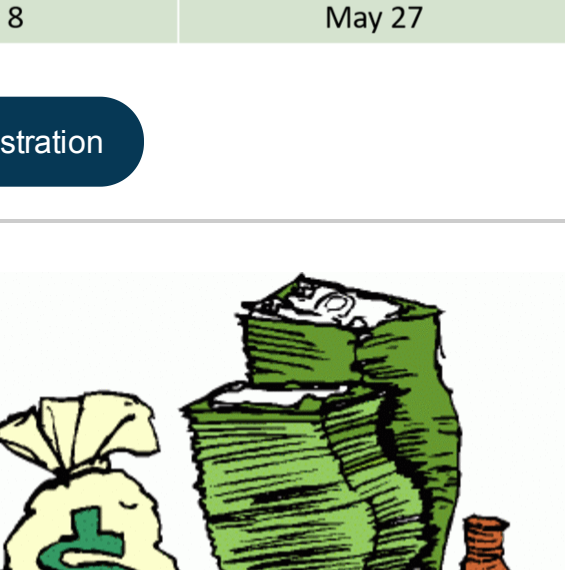
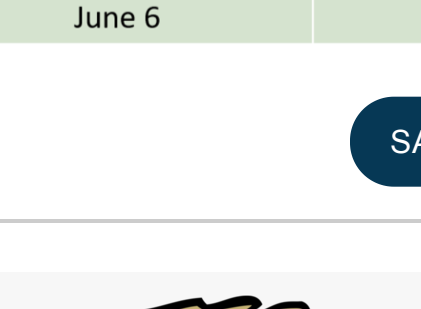
Soddy Daisy High School Faculty & Staff share some thoughts on their own college experiences.

ACT / SAT Testing Dates

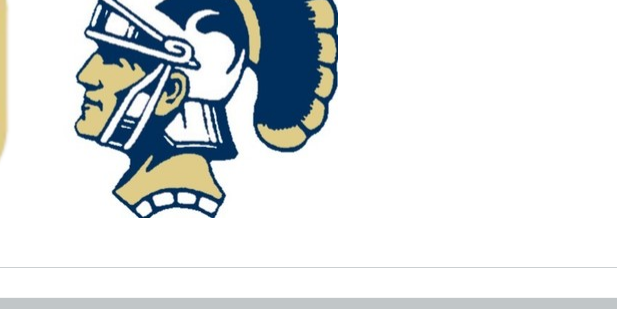

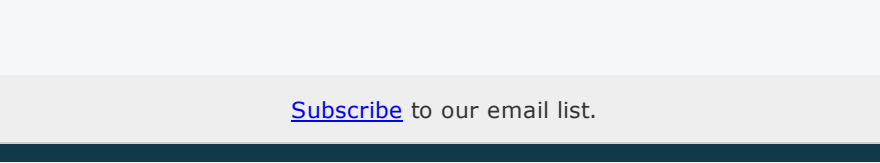

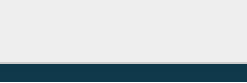
